ROSPHOTO employees selected more than 300 photos from the ICRC archive, covering humanitarian activities to protect children. The exposition series covers the period from the First World War to the present. A series of military conflicts, natural disasters and their consequences are reflected in the work of photographers who collaborated with the International Committee of the Red Cross. The exhibition unites the best photos, made by documentary and military photographers. Both of them participated in the creation of the St. Petersburg Association "Education for All", on behalf of which they acted, trying to give chance to different children to be included as much as possible in the education system and develop among ordinary children.
